PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

SUPERVISION & MENTORING

This position will be supervised and organized by a Property Manager. Work plans and locations will be assigned daily; reliable transportation to work sites will be required. This position will be mentored by one of our full-time Maintenance employees. Students will participate in Mandatory Health & Safety Orientation prior to commencing any work.
